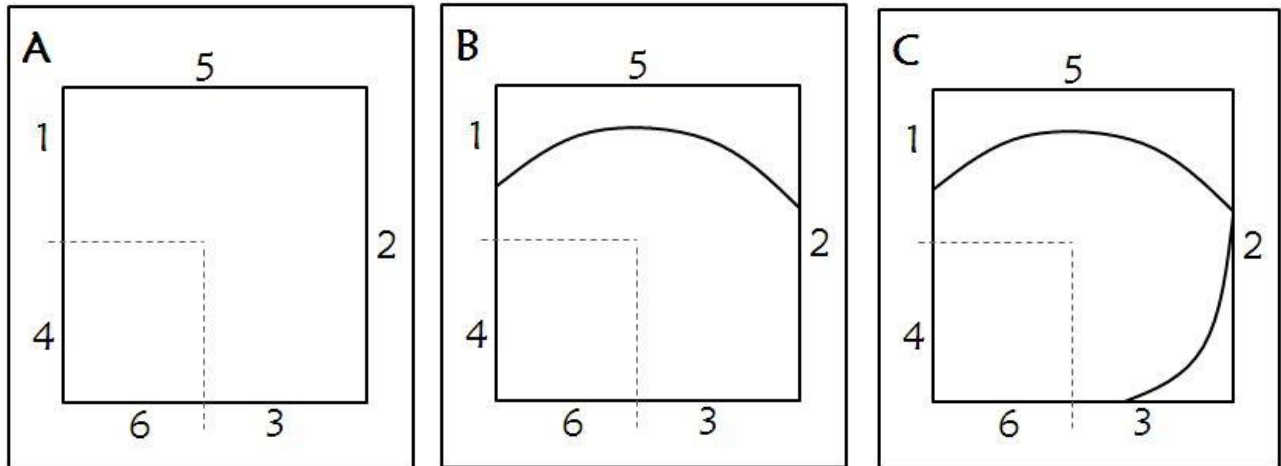
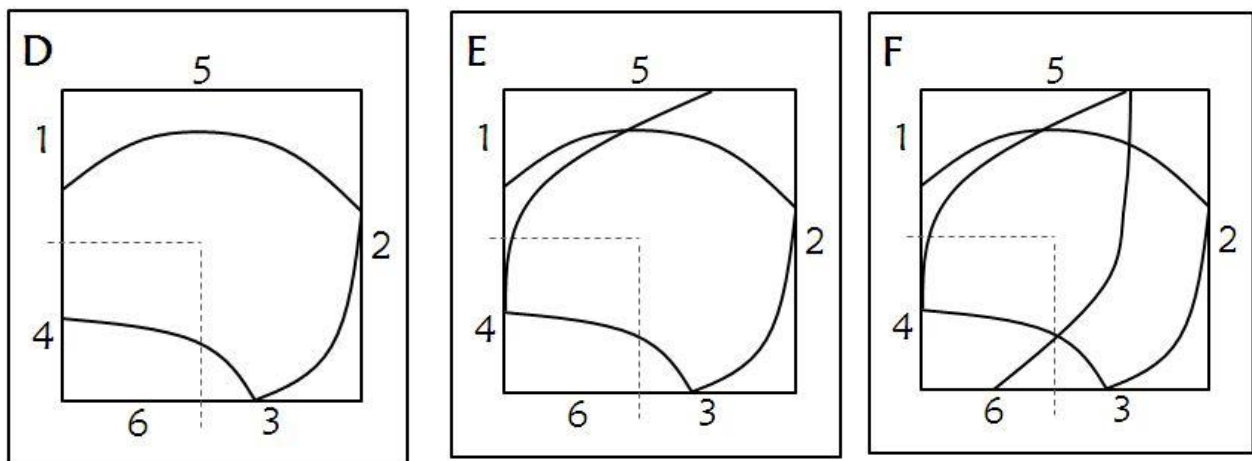


How to design a simple Knox Knot!

Let's practice bouncing a curved line like a ball to the different sides of the boxes to make interesting Archibald Knox style shapes.



- Start with a numbered box, just like the one drawn above called **Box A**
- Begin by drawing a line anywhere from the side numbered **1** to anywhere on the side numbered **2**. **Box B**. A curved line looks good.
- Next go from anywhere from the side numbered **2** to anywhere within the side numbered **3**. **Box C**



- Repeat another curved line from the side numbered **3** to the side numbered **4**. **Box D**
- Repeat from the side numbered **4** to the side number **5**. **Box E**
- Finally end by drawing a line from the side numbered **5** to anywhere in the side numbered **6**. **Box F**. **You have completed a simple knot!**
- Next go to page 2.
