

Edmund Southworth, has held the post of Director at Manx National Heritage since 2009 and is scheduled to retire in the Spring of 2021. Edmund has had a long career in Museums and Heritage – starting work as an archaeologist in his native Lancashire in 1977.

He later spent 20 years as a curator at the National Museums in Liverpool before becoming the County Museums Officer for Lancashire in 2000. He has just joined the Board of the York Archaeological Trust.

In his time at MNH, Edmund has overseen a wide range of developments and changes which have brought it into the digital age and given MNH a stronger role in the community. The charity remains a close partner with the Isle of Man Government and works closely with public and private sector partners to improve the quality of life on the Island.

The Isle of Man is a British Crown Dependency with no access to HLF or EU funds and MNH is the National Trust for the Island as well as the National Museum and Library service.
