Frequently Asked Questions

- **When is the event on?**

The largest Heritage event in the Isle of Man's calendar is returning next month, when Heritage Open Days 2022 will place over two consecutive weekends; Friday 30th September to Sunday 2nd October and Friday 7th October to Sunday 9th October 2022.

- **What is I can no longer use tickets for an event?**

Events are often oversubscribed so by cancelling your ticket you give someone else the chance to attend.

- **Are the events accessible for disabled persons?**

Please see the programme for events which are accessible for disabled persons including wheelchair users. Events indicated with a  symbol have been assessed as accessible for wheelchair users. Other events and tours may be partially accessible or accessible with assistance. Please note not all participating venues have accessible toilets.

- **Do I need to wear a face covering?**

A face covering may give added protection if you, or someone you are in close contact with, are at risk of serious illness from COVID-19 or other respiratory infections.

Please help us to keep everyone safe by not attending any Heritage Open Day event if you have the symptoms of COVID-19 or have tested positive.
