P50 Gift Competition Rules

If you submit an entry into the P50 Gift Competition you are agreeing to follow the below rules of the competition

You must read and abide by these Rules as they create a legally binding contract between you and MMNT.

Manx National Heritage is the trading name of the Manx Museum and National Trust ("MMNT"), which is registered as a charity in the Isle of Man with charity number 603 and is subject to Isle of Man law.

1) About the Competition

The competition is to guess the number of gifts inside the Peel P50 car in the reception area of the House of Manannan, Peel.

- The competition will run from 9:30am 23rd November 2024 till 4:30pm 5th January 2025 .
- The competition is open to all ages; however for under Under-16s, a parent/guardian name must be on the entry slip.
- 1 entry is allowed per person
- If no one guesses the correct answer the closest answer will be the winner. If more than 1 person guesses the correct answer, we will place each entry into a random generator program to select the winner at random.
- We will call & email the winner the week commencing 6th January 2025

2) Entry to the competition

- Entries must be received by 4:30pm 5th January 2025
- Entry is only available in person at the House of Manannan
- Anyone with a family member (i) involved in its organisation or (ii) employed or volunteers at MMNT or The Manx Transport Heritage Museum are precluded from entering the Competition.
- By submitting an entry to the Competition, you agree:
 - i) to abide by the Rules and ensure that your entry complies with the Rules.
 - ii) (ii) to maintain the highest standards in all matters relating to the Competition.
 - iii) (iii) not to do or say anything that does or might damage the reputation of the Competition, MMNT, The Manx Transport Heritage Museum or the other entrants.

- iv) Any entry found not to comply with the Rules at any stage of the Competition may be disqualified. No allowances will be made in the event of disqualification and any prizes will be forfeited.
- v) Whilst the information in these Rules is correct, we, in our sole discretion but acting reasonably, reserve the right without prior notice to:
 - amend or vary the Rules.
 - change the prizes in accordance with section 7 (7);
 - decide whether any Competition award ceremony will be an event or carried out online only.
 - waive breaches of the Rules; and/ or
 - cancel the Competition and terminate the contracts and licences created by these Rules.

3) Prize

- The prize for guessing the correct number of gifts is for **1** annual pass to our sites.
- The prize is non-transferable. We reserve the right, at our convenience, to substitute the whole or part of the prize with an alternative of equal monetary value (but you shall not have any right to demand this). Please note that the prize must be claimed within one year of the notification of success, or if the prize has a fixed occurrence date then up to one (1) month prior to that occurrence date, or it will be forfeited (including any right to receive any substitute prize).

4) Data Protection

- We will collect personal data about you (and the parent/guardian where applicable) at the time of entering and as otherwise provided in order to administer the Competition. 5) Events Beyond MMNT's Reasonable Control

- We shall not be in breach of these Rules nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of MMNT's obligations under these Rules if such delay or failure result from events, circumstances or causes beyond MMNT's reasonable control. In such circumstances, we shall be entitled to a reasonable extension of the time for performing such obligations. If the period of delay or non-performance continues for 1 week, we may terminate the contract created by these Rules by giving you 14 days' written notice.

6) Entire Agreement

- These Rules and any other webpages or documents incorporated into them constitute the entire agreement between you and us and supersedes and extinguishes all previous agreements, promises, assurances, warranties, representations and understandings between them, whether written or oral, relating to its subject matter, including but not limited to any advertising or promotional materials. You agree that you shall have no remedies in respect of any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether made innocently or negligently) that is not set out in these Rules.

7) Law and Jurisdiction

- The Rules shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with Isle of Man law and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Isle of Man courts. This competition is administered by Manx Museum and National Trust.
