Wild Mann – Nature Photographer Competition – Privacy Notice

Who we are

The data controller is the Manx Museum and National Trust (“MMNT”), trading as Manx National Heritage (“MNH”).

See our contact details below under the heading ‘Data Protection Officer’.

Your personal data

To enter the competition you will be asked to provide us with the following personal data:

- Name of entrant
- Name of parent/guardian for entrant under 18
- Age if under 18
- Address
- Telephone number
- Email address
- Signature

Additionally, we may collect information about your profession and payments received for your photography work as part of our background checks.

Legal basis for processing your information

We may only process your personal information if there is a legal basis (a lawful reason) for us to do so.

The legal basis for processing your information when you enter this Competition is as follows:

- Consent – if we rely on your consent to process your information you may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting Manx National Heritage or the MNH Data Protection Officer (contact details below);
- The need to fulfil obligations under a contract, namely the Competition Terms and Conditions;
- The need to retain information for historical or archiving purposes by the Public Record Office under the Public Records Act 1999.

This is set out in Articles 6(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Schedule to the Data Protection (Application of GDPR) Order 2018 – this legislation is sometimes called “the Applied GDPR”.





Sharing your information

Manx National Heritage may contact you to discuss your contribution and/or to verify your age and check that you have the permission of a parent or guardian to participate in the competition. Your entry (but not your contact details) will be shared with the judges and, if your entry features in the exhibition, we will share the entry and your name, and age if a child, with Magnolia Box, who are contracted to make the prints for us.

Your information will not be shared with anyone outside Manx National Heritage, with the exception of:

- your entry details (full name of adult; first name and age of child) for those to be featured in the exhibition and with Magnolia Box who are contracted to make the prints: <https://www.magnoliabox.com/collections/manx-national-heritage-prints>;
- your name and email address with WeTransfer in order to transfer your large electronic image files (but not your entry forms) to our competition inbox for processing <https://wetransfer.com/>.

Storing your information

The security and confidentiality of your information is very important to us. We will ensure that:

- Safeguards are in place to make sure personal information is kept securely
- Only authorised staff are able to view your information

If you are successful in being one of the finalists to feature in the exhibition, Manx National Heritage will retain your data indefinitely. This is for legal compliance purposes (i.e. archiving for the public record) and in case we need to contact you again in future, for example because we wish to feature your photo again.

If you are unsuccessful, Manx National Heritage will retain your information until 7 months after the competition close and will then destroy it in line with our data retention policy.

Your rights

The Applied GDPR (data protection legislation) provides you as a data subject with some rights to be informed of the processing of your personal data, including the right to access that data and information about the purposes for processing.

This includes a right to correct (rectify) any information we hold, or to restrict it in certain circumstances.

If we are relying on your consent to process your data, you also the right to have your data deleted (erasure), although please note that it may be difficult to remove your images if they have been published, e.g. via social media.

If Manx National Heritage is processing your data in order to comply with our legal obligations, certain elements of the data protection rights do not apply, including the right to have your data deleted (erasure), transferred to another provider or the right to object to the processing.

Note that we will not make any automated decisions or profile your data for purposes of this Competition and exhibition, or at any time subsequently.
